HAMPTON COURT PALACE



Itinerary:

Hampton Court Palace is one of the Historic Royal Palaces which is primarily known as the primary residence of King Henry VIII. After acquiring it from Cardinal Thomas Wolsey in 1529, the king transformed it into a magnificent royal residence. During your visit you will see the Tudor sections which are characterised by distinctive red brickwork, beautiful elaborate chimneys and a very impressive great Hall, where the king hosted state banquets. Over the centuries, the palace has been home to several other monarchs, including William III and Mary II, who added elegant Baroque facades, state apartments and the famous Fountain Court designed by Sir Christopher Wren. The palace is situated on the river Thames and is surrounded by over 60 acres of formal gardens, including the celebrated Privy Garden, the Maze, and the Great Vine—one of the oldest and largest grapevines in the world.
